What is NCQA's CWP Measure?

- The CWP measure monitors the percentage of episodes for members 3 years and older where the member was:
 - diagnosed with pharyngitis
 - dispensed an antibiotic
 - and received a group A streptococcus (strep) test
- The look back period for this measure begins July 1 of the year prior to the measurement year and ends on June 30 of the measurement year.
- This measure looks for the date of service for any outpatient, telephone, observation or ED visit, e-visit
 or virtual check-in during the look back period with a diagnosis of pharyngitis.

What is NCQA's CWP Measure?

- The age stratifications for this measures are:
 - 3-17 years old
 - 18-64 years old
 - 65 years and older
 - Total (sum of tall stratifications)
- A member may be in this measure for multiple episodes.
- This measure is only an administrative measure which means that the only way to get credit for this
 is to submit the appropriate code on a claim.
- Health Partners Plans <u>may not perform</u> medical record review for the AAP measure.



Examples of Best Practices Documentation

- Perform a rapid strep test and/or a throat culture to confirm diagnosis before prescribing antibiotics.
- Do not treat any sign/symptoms of possible strep throat with antibiotics unless a rapid strep test and/or
 a throat culture is performed.
- Document results of the rapid strep test and/or they throat culture.
- Document refusals of testing for strep by members.
- Submit co-morbid diagnosis coded that apply to the visit on the claim.
- Document and code accurately if antibiotics are prescribed for another condition.

Examples of Best Practices Documentation

- Educate patients, parents and families on:
 - Difference between viral and bacterial infections.
 - Inappropriate use of antibiotics.
 - Explain other causes for sore throats such as colds or allergies.
 - Offers ways to treat symptoms such as:
 - Increased fluids by mouth
 - Over the counter medicines
 - Cool mist vaporizer
 - Throat lozenges
 - Rest
 - Explain ways to prevent infection:
 - Wash hands frequently
 - Clean children's toys
 - Wipe down frequently touched areas with disinfectant wipes
